PROVIDING TIME FOR FUN INTERACTION 15 MINUTES

MADE TO MOVE

an activity that uses a preschooler's natural desire to move to help



1. BUBBLES

WHAT YOU NEED: Bubble solution and a large bubble wand or machine

NOTE: We recommend that you only use a hand operated wand or bubble machine to prevent from having to blow bubbles with your mouth during the Covid-19 pandemic.

TODAY'S BIBLE STORY

Jesus loves me and wants to spend time with me.

MARY AND MARTHA LUKE 10:38-42

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Have the children stand in front of you.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Blow the bubbles toward the children. Encourage the children to pop all of the bubbles with their friends. Repeat several times.

MEMORY VERSE

"A friend loves at all times."
PROVERBS 17:17, NIRV

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "I am so excited to play with bubbles!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "When I blow the bubbles, you may pop them with your friends. Are you ready? (*Do activity.*) Great job!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "We'll hear a wonderful Bible story about how Jesus wants to be our friend."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by chanting "Jesus wants to be my friend forever" as you walk to the story area.

KEY QUESTION

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PROVIDING TIME FOR FUN INTERACTION 15 MINUTES

MADE TO PLAY

an activity that encourages preschoolers to follow guidelines while having fun and learning new concepts



2. WHO'S THERE?

WHAT YOU NEED: Cardboard boxes in a variety of sizes, plush animals, and a utility knife

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Cut door flaps in the boxes and hide the animals behind the doors.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Have children knock on the doors and open them to see the friends behind. Repeat as long as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how we'll hear a story about a special visitor who knocked on the door of two sisters.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Let's play a knock-knock game."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Knock on the door. (*Pause.*) Who's there? Open the door and see who it is. (*Pause.*) It's a special friend. Hello, friend! (*Pause.*) Knock on another door." (*Repeat as long as desired.*)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Today, we'll hear a story about two sisters who had a special friend come to their house."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by telling knock-knock jokes: Knock-knock. Who's there? [Child's name]. [Child's name] who? [Child's name] come to the circle.

MADE TO EXPLORE

an activity that channels a preschooler's innate curiosity into a discussion of the week's crucial concepts



3. TIDYING UP

WHAT YOU NEED: Preschool-sized brooms, dust pans, and dust cloths or tissues

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Place the brooms, dustpans, and cloths or tissues around the activity area.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Invite the children to sweep and dust around the activity area. Be sure each child has a turn to sweep and dust.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Our room looks a little dirty."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Let's use these cool brooms and cloths (hold up) to dust our room and sweep our floors!" (Do activity.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "You did a great job making our room look nice. Today in our Bible story, we'll hear about someone who made their house look nice for a special friend."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by pretending to sweep as you move to the story area.

CREATING A SAFE PLACE TO CONNECT 25 MINUTES

MADE TO MOVE

TODAY'S BIBLE STORY

Jesus loves me and wants to spend time with me. MARY AND MARTHA LUKE 10:38-42

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1. MEMORY VERSE WITH MOTIONS

[HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: Colored construction paper or cardstock, scissors, and floor tape

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Cut large circles out of the paper or cardstock, one per child. Be sure the circles are an rent colors. Tape the circles in pairs on the floor around the

assortment of different colors. Tape the circles in pairs on the floor around the room.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Ask the children to run to a circle. When they arrive, they will have a friend next to them. Say the memory verse with the children. Ask the children to run to another circle so they can stand with a "new" friend. Say the memory verse again. Repeat several times.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Jesus wants to be our friend forever! Let's say our memory verse with our friends."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "When I say, 'Go,' you may run to any circle. When you get to your circle, you will have a friend standing on a circle next you. Let's try it! GO. Great job! I see so many friends! Let's say our memory verse together with our friends!" (Continue and finish activity.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Our memory verse tells us that friends love each other all the time! Jesus loves us and wants to be our friend forever! Who loves you? Jesus loves me!"



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2. SIT AND STAND

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW] WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Gather the children around you.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Tell the children to listen very carefully. When you say, "Mary," everyone must sit down and look at you. When you say, "Martha," everyone must jump up and pretend to sweep.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how Jesus wanted to spend time with His friends, Mary and Martha. Mary sat and listened to Jesus, but Marth was too busy and did not sit down.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "I love seeing all my friends here today! Come over here and stand with me."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "We're going to play a game. When I say, 'Mary,' I want everyone to sit down really fast like this. (*Sit down.*) Then look at me. (*Point to yourself.*) When I say, 'Martha,' I want everyone to stand up really fast like this. (*Stand up.*) Then pretend to sweep, like this. (*Demonstrate.*) Ok, let's play!"

(Say "Mary" and "Martha" as you would in a Stop and Go game. Continue playing as time and attention allow.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Jesus went to see His friends, Mary and Martha, because He wanted to spend time with them. Mary sat and listened to Jesus, but Marth was too busy and did not sit down. Jesus wants to spend time you and you and you . . . (point to each child), because He loves you and you and you . . . (point to each child again). Who loves you? Jesus loves me!"



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3. DANCE

[LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Music player and the monthly song, "Whole Lotta Bit"

WHAT YOU DO:

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Play monthly song and encourage the children to dance to the music. Repeat as

desired.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Let's spend time with each other and with Jesus! We can praise Him and dance together!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, you have some awesome dance moves! That was so fun spending time with each other and with Jesus! Who loves you?

Jesus loves me!"

MADE TO CREATE

an activity that allows preschoolers to review the Bible story, bottom line, or memory verse by creating a craft to take home

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Jesus wants to be my friend forever.



4. MARY, MARTHA, AND JESUS [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Mary, Martha, and Jesus" and "Special Friend" Activity Pages; cardstock; scissors; glue sticks; heart stamps; red washable ink pads; and wet wipes

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Mary, Martha, and Jesus" on cardstock, one per child. Copy "Special Friend" on cardstock and cut, one per child.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to glue Jesus between Mary and Martha then stamp it all over with hearts.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how Jesus wants to spend time with you and me.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Today in our story, we heard how two sisters, Mary and Martha, had a special friend come to visit. Jesus was the special friend who came to visit with Mary and Martha."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "On your paper, I see Mary sitting on one side and Martha holding a broom on the other side. Glue Jesus in the middle of the sisters. (*Pause.*) Great job! Jesus loves you and me and wants to spend time with us. Stamp hearts all over your paper. (*Pause.*) Terrific."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Both sisters were very excited that Jesus was coming to visit, but Martha was busy with cooking and cleaning while Mary sat and talked with Jesus. This made Martha upset, but Jesus told Martha that spending time with Him was the best thing to do. Jesus doesn't need everything to be just right. Jesus loves us, no matter what, and wants to spend time with us. Who loves you? Jesus loves me."

GETTING READY

HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET READY FOR THIS WEEK

SOCIAL: PROVIDING TIME FOR FUN INTERACTION (15 MINUTES)

Activities that encourage preschoolers to enter the classroom and begin engaging with peers and Small Group Leaders by providing age appropriate and hands on fun while introducing new concepts they will hear in the day's Bible story.

Prepare to offer one or more of the following activities as your 2-year-olds arrive. Let one or two teachers lead small groups of children in activities throughout the room while another teacher greets parents and children at the door. At this age not all children will participate, but most will want to be part of the fun.

GROUPS: CREATING A SAFE PLACE TO CONNECT (25 MINUTES)

Create a safe place to connect through activities that are written to reach every learning style while reinforcing the Bottom Line that was introduced during the Bible Story and applying it to real life experiences. In addition, these activities provide preschoolers with an opportunity to build relationships with their Small Group Leader.

Prepare to offer one or more of the following activities after the Bible Story. Let one or two teachers lead small groups of children in activities throughout the room. At this age, not all children will participate, but most will want to be part of the fun
