- Jesus is the one perfect sacrifice that covers our sins.
- Do you believe in the resurrection?
- Acts 2:24: ²⁴ But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.
- ...because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.
- 32 God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it.
- Multiple witnesses/Historical Evidence/Growth of the Chruch
- "Christ is the end of the Law." Or "Christ is the end of legalism."
- Romans 10:9-13: 9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
- 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
- It is a prayer that leads into a path of life
- 11 As Scripture says, "Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame." 12 For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, 13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- Jesus resurrection allows us to know we are loved and know we are loved despite our failures.
- Are you living in the joy of the resurrection?
- The resurrection is the proof of our salvation
